Scope of Services

The City of Chattanooga is looking for a vendor to provide document set up, printing, and mailing services for summonses and notice letters that will be sent to delinquent tax payers in preparation for the upcoming City of Chattanooga Tax Year 2016 Delinquent Tax Sale. In each mail batch, the City will send a summons or notice letter to each property owner on the City's delinquent tax list that contains information that is specific to the property at issue (e.g. the property address, tax map ID, legal description of the property etc.). Thus, the City seeks a vendor that will be able to do the following:

Use data extracted from a Microsoft Excel spreadsheet to generate a personalized summons or notice letter for each property and property owner on the City's delinquent tax list. The Excel spreadsheet will be provided by the City.

QuestMark is able to accept any input data format, including excel, extract data, process the data, and produce output in virtually any output format. Input and Output formats also can include printer output, PDF, CSV, Excel, Word, JSON, XML, plain text, and any other industry standard format.

o A template version of the summons or notice letter will be provided by the City in Microsoft Word and will be set up so that the specific property/property owner information from the spreadsheet can be mail merged into the document.

This will be implemented by our programming department based on business rules and parameters provided for each version of summons and notices to the specific spreadsheet. Microsoft Word format is a perfectly acceptable format for QuestMark to use to configure the document templates in our system.

Send drafts of the mail merged summonses or notice letters to the City for review and approval before the documents are sent out into the mail stream.

QuestMark will provide draft samples to the City for review prior to mailing. Our entire process is outlined as follows:

<u>Overview:</u> QuestMark offers the City of Chattanooga a total systems approach for mail processing. The following is an overview of QuestMark's proposed system:

- All summons, motions and notices will be printed/rendered at QuestMark.
- Forms and envelopes will be printed in advance and stored by QuestMark.
- The management of the forms and envelopes including ordering, offset printing, shipping and storage will be handled by QuestMark.
- QuestMark will provide 18-month NCOA processing. The addresses will then be processed through certified USPS presort software to CASS certify addresses and apply the IMb to conform with USPS requirements.

The City will upload excel files to QuestMark via SFTP. Once the files are received on QuestMark's SFTP server, the file is automatically encrypted using QuestMark's PGP key and moved to our processing system behind the firewall. An email is sent to City personnel confirming receipt of files, totals and count.

QuestMark's data processing department proceeds to process the files. A job jacket and tracking number are created allowing for quality control checkpoints throughout production. Recorded on this job jacket are the specific job instructions, number of envelopes, documents, and pages in the job. This job jacket follows the job until completion.



Data files are processed:

- Exclusion rules applied, where applicable (for example, E-BILL, ACH, and others as identified in print file).
- NCOA/CASS Certification.
- Application of sorter codes, as approved.
- Render document (print ready data) into proper bill format.
- Apply postal barcodes and scan lines.
- Print output files are queued.
- A report is generated for the City stating that the file has been processed and PDFs are available for review and approval.
- NCOA reports (Moves) are reported at the time of processing. This data is uploaded to our portal, QMDepot.
- When approval is received, files are spooled for laser printing and job jacket handed to the laser print department to begin the production process.
- PDF's will be uploaded to QMDepot for retrieval, and an email will be sent indicating PDFs are available.

Upon receiving approval from the City, mail the summonses or notice letters to the property owners via United States Postal Service ("USPS") certified mail.

Print and Letter Shop Production

The job jacket is received by the print department. The print technicians stage the printers for the job. Stock specific to the job will be pulled from inventory. Redundant print equipment and on-site vendor technicians guarantee minimal downtime of any hardware. Our print technicians have extensive experience in printing all types of documents, simplex, duplex, single, and multiple-page documents. Our years of experience have resulted in thoroughly documented procedures and quality results. All printing is recorded and documented against the original page counts. Output is printed in batches that are verified utilizing a recap sheet where a begin page control number and end page control number are recorded thereon. Consistent, high-quality printing is always maintained.

After batches are printed and checked for print quality, they are sent to our letter shop. The batches, along with the job jacket are received by the shop production manager. The shop production manager oversees the entire process. Redundant mail equipment and on-site technician guarantee minimal downtime of any mail equipment.

The bindery operator refers to the envelope on the job jacket to determine the correct fold to ensure the address shows in the window. The recap sheet is reviewed to confirm that all batches are accounted for and quantity folded matches. The bindery operator than signs off on the job jacket.

The job is then given to a sorter who is responsible for reviewing and following the instructions on the job jacket, e.g., #9 envelope, an insert is to be included. Envelopes and material received are verified against examples stapled to the job jacket. The job is set up to insert. The shop manager reviews the job jacket, material used in setup, and signs off on each mailing. The operator and sorter review material and address placement throughout the inserting process. The completed mail pieces are placed in trays, sleeved, and tagged. The finished count is verified against the original count.

Mail is delivered to the USPS Bulk Mail Entry Unit (BMEU) within 24 hours of approval.

USPS bulk mail acceptance days do not include Saturdays, Sundays, or U.S. Government holidays.



Provide the City with electronic copies of the USPS signature sheets that contain signatures, tracking information, and/or return information for each certified mailing that is sent out. For letters marked to be mailed as USPS Certified Mail®, QuestMark's system generates a unique USPS IMpb (Intelligent Mail Package Barcode) to your mail piece. This barcode will include instructions to USPS such as capturing the recipient's signature. QuestMark will also handle the electonic communication to USPS along with retreival of the signature sheets (proof of delivery "POD" PDFs) and tracking information.

As the information is retreived, it will be indexed by tax ID (or other fields as defined by the City), packaged (e.g., Zip File), and electronically sent back to the City.




