Councilmen Benson and Littlefield were both out of the City. City Attorney Randall Nelson, Management Analyst Randy Burns, and Shirley Crownover, Assistant Clerk to the Council, were also present.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/INVOCATION

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Taylor, followed by the invocation.

MINUTE APPROVAL

On motion of Councilman Lively, seconded by Councilman Page, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved as published and signed in open meeting.

REZONING

Councilman Pierce was not able to attend the committee meeting and asked for an explanation of this. Adm. Mitchell explained that this was a five-year plan for the Auditorium and the Tivoli and included the dressing room and ceiling; also handrails, stairs, carpets and restrooms. Councilman Pierce asked about the little theatre upstairs. Adm. Mitchell indicated that this would be attended to at a later date. He also explained that this was adopted in last year's Capital Budget, and we plan \$200,000 a year for renovations for the next five years.

Councilman Hakeem noted that Resolutions © through (g) were all discussed in last week's Public Works Committee and come with a recommendation for approval.
