

# City Council Building Chattanooga, Tennessee COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

February 4, 2014 6:00 PM

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

# RECOGNITION OF PERSONS WISHING TO ADDRESS COUNCIL (Non-Agenda Items)

 Kirk Salter (City Retiree) - Opposes reducing the Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) for Fire & Police retirees

- Johnny Frazier (Retired, Fire Dept.) He holds the Council responsible for not keeping the fire and police pension fully funded.
  - Chairman Hakeem addressed Mr. Frazier's concerns.
- Ron Delker (Retired, Fire Dept.) Opposes reducing the cost of living adjustment for Fire & Police retirees
- Chip O'Dell (Fire Dept.) Inquired as to why city employees have not been informed about the State Treasurer's report requiring cities to fully fund pensions.
  - o Travis McDonough addressed Mr. O'Dell's concerns.
- Steven West (SEIU) He discussed two issues: (1) Heating needed for employees at Summit Landfill and (2) Reassignment of two employees at the Youth and Family Development Centers.
