ORDINANCE NO.	12437

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING THE 1900 BLOCK OF ALLIN STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That there be and is hereby closed and abandoned the 1900 block of Allin Street right-of-way, more particularly described below and as shown on the maps attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference:

Abandonment of the 1900 block of Allin Street beginning at its intersection with the east line of the 3400 block of North Orchard Knob Avenue thence continuing southeast some 126 feet to the west line of the railroad right-of-way now or formerly owned by Southern Railway. Said street separates part of Block 9, Map of East Chattanooga Middle Section from part of the unopened 3400 block of North Orchard Knob Avenue. Tax Map No. 127L-G-005.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this closure and abandonment shall be subject to:

- 1. The applicant reconstructing the entrance to the railroad service road (shifting it to the south of its current location), if necessary; and
- 2. The abandoned right-of-way will become part of the adjacent parcels (equally, approximately 40 feet to the applicant and approximately 40 feet to the Railroad; and
- 3. Applicant to provide a survey showing new property line (after abandonment) and the existing service road location.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two




