

ORDINANCE NO. 12448

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE, PART II, CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE X, SECTIONS 24-303(a) and (b), RELATIVE TO OFF-STREET PARKING REQUIRED FOR PERSONS PARKED TRANSACTING BUSINESS FROM VEHICLES AND CARTS IN THE CITY.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 24, Article X, Sections 24-303(a) and (b), be and are hereby amended by deleting same in their entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (c) of this section and in article XIII of chapter 11 of this Code, it shall be unlawful for any person to sell, give away, or purchase merchandise from a parked motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, push cart, motorized cart, bicycle-propelled cart, animal-drawn wagon or cart, table, crate, carton, rack, or other similar device on public streets, sidewalks, or rights-of-way abutting any property in the City.
- (b) Except as provided in paragraph (c) of this section and in article XIII of chapter 11 of this Code, it shall be unlawful for any person to sell, give away or purchase merchandise from a parked motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, push-cart, motorized-cart, bicycle-propelled cart, animal-drawn wagon or cart, table, crate, carton, rack, or other similar device in any parking space on public streets or right-of-way in the city that is controlled by a parking meter or which is located in a parking meter zone designated by section 24-505 of this Code.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two in medicately (2) weeks from and after its passage.
