ORDINANCE NO. 13220

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE, PART II, CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE X, SECTION 24-388(e), (f), AND (g), RELATING TO VALET PARKING.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 24, Article X, Section 24-388, Subsections (e) and (f) are hereby amended by deleting the subsections in their entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 24-388. On-Street Valet Parking services, permits, terms, etc.

- (e) Upon approval of an application for a valet parking permit, the applicant shall remit a fee in the amount to be determined by the Transportation Department, according to the following guidelines:
 - 1. Regardless of the time of day in which the spaces will be used, the permit holder shall pay a minimum fixed fee of three dollars (\$3.00) per day to be assessed for each valet parking loading space used.
 - 2. During the times and days of valet operation, when otherwise the spaces are unavailable to the general public, the permit-holder shall pay a fee equivalent to standard meter fees that would be assessed to the general public to lawfully pay the meter during those times.
 - 3. For all permit-holders, regardless of the amount of time the parking spaces are unavailable to the general public, the maximum fee shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per day.
 - 4. Redevelopment and new construction projects may request a waiver of fees for up to a maximum of five (5) years. The Transportation Department will base consideration for waivers on new on-street parking or significant, voluntary investment in the Right-of-Way. Requests for waivers may only occur at the time of valet parking permit application and will be considered at the sole discretion of the Transportation Department.

(f) The Transportation Department or its designee may at their discretion limit the number of spaces and the duration of the permit. The Transportation Department or its designee shall not issue any valet parking permit if, in the Transportation Department's opinion, the use of such requested parking space(s) would interfere with any work in the right-of-way or with any event to be held in the right-of-way.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 24, Article X, Section 24-388 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (g) as follows:

(g) Upon approval of such permit, the Transportation Department or its designee shall designate the parking spaces to be used by placing a bag over the meter(s) or signing and using pavement markings to define the space(s) reserved by the permit.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two (2) weeks upon passage of a second reading.
