



Preliminary Planned Unit Development Plan

 The property adjacent to the area included in this plan will not be adversely affected.

(2) The plan is consistent with the intent and purpose of the Chattanooga Zoning Ordinance to promote public health, safety, morals and general welfare.

- (3) That the buildings shall be used only for single-family dwellings, two-family dwellings, and the usual accessory uses such as private or storage garages, storage space, and for community activities, including school and/or churches.
