## RESOLUTION NO. 24260

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CHATTANOOGA-HAMILTON COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING AGENCY TO CONDUCT A ZONING ADJUSTMENT STUDY FOR CERTAIN PROPERTIES LOCATED IN THE ST. ELMO NEIGHBORHOOD, AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP, AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO CHANGE THE CURRENT ZONING TO THE APPROPRIATE ZONE THAT REFLECTS THE CURRENT LAND USE PATTERNS.

WHEREAS, through an extensive public planning process (the St. Elmo Community Plan), it has been determined that there is a convincing need to conduct a zoning adjustment study within the St. Elmo neighborhood in order to better represent current and future land uses within the study area which are consistent with the development character of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the study area is generally defined as an area bounded on the north by Old Wauhatchie Pike and the Southern Railroad, on the south by the Tennessee / Georgia state line, on the east by West Avenue and Hawkins Ridge, and on the west by the Chattanooga city limit line; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the study is to make recommendations to change the current zoning to the appropriate zoning to reflect the current land use; and

WHEREAS, a moratorium on any new construction for duplex and or multi-family units is necessary until the completion of the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Regional Planning Agency's zoning adjustment recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Regional Planning Agency be and is

hereby requested to conduct a zoning adjustment study for the purpose of recommending zoning

changes for the St. Elmo neighborhood as shown on the attached map and made apart hereof by

reference.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That there be and is hereby declared a moratorium on
