

RESOLUTION NO. 25670

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND, IF APPROVED, ACCEPT A BROWNFIELD GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) RELATIVE TO ENVIRONMENTAL JOB TRAINING IN BROWNFIELD COMMUNITIES IN AN AMOUNT UP TO TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000.00).

WHEREAS the EPA provides funding up to \$200,000 for two (2) years to provide environmental job training for low-income residents in the Brownfield communities;

WHEREAS, Chattanooga State, Chattanooga Housing Authority, Signal Center, The Career Center, and several environmental firms have committed to partner with the City on this initiative;

WHEREAS, The Chattanooga-Hamilton County Regional Planning Agency will be responsible for managing this grant;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for and, if approved, accept a Brownfield Grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) relative to environmental job training in Brownfield communities in an amount up to \$200,000.00.
