

RESOLUTION NO. 25835

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, FISCAL YEAR 2008 INTEROPERABLE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS GRANT PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$89,354.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, that the General Services Division be and is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, acceptance a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security through the Emergency Management Agency, Fiscal Year 2008 Inoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program, 2008-IO-T8-0045, in the amount of \$89,354.00. Such grants provide planning, training, and exercise funding to carry out initiatives to improve interoperable emergency communications, including communications in collective response to natural disasters, acts of terrorism, and other man-made disasters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Chattanooga do hereby express their sincere gratitude to the United States Department of Homeland Security for said grant.
