A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING KAREN L. Loveless (hereinafter referred to as "Temporary User") be and is hereby permitted to use temporarily the right-of-way at 116 Cross Street to install a six (6') foot wide handicap ramp that will service a new banquet space currently under construction, as shown on the drawings attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said temporary usage shall be subject to the following additional conditions:

- 1. The handicapped ramp must meet ADA standards.
- 2. The construction and installation of the handicapped ramp must meet all City of Chattanooga codes and requirements.
- 3. Temporary User shall execute the Indemnification Agreement attached hereto in favor of the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees for any and all claims for damages for injuries to persons or property related to or arising out of the temporary usage.
- 4. Temporary User agrees to vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so.
- 5. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.


