RESOLUTION NO. 26286

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF ZACHARY WILEY AS SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER THE (UNARMED) FOR CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES DIVISION, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Zachary Wiley be and is hereby appointed as a special police officer (unarmed) for the City of Chattanooga, Neighborhood Services Division, subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

- 1. That said special police officer shall have, possess, and exercise every power, except as hereinafter limited, granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officer are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Code Enforcement Inspector 1 for the City of Chattanooga.
- 2. That said special police officer shall not be considered an employee of the Chattanooga Police Department, nor shall he be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers of the City, and shall in all respects be considered an employee of the City of Chattanooga, Neighborhood Services Division.
- 3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special policeman's employment in the Neighborhood Services Division. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
