A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF CHARLES R. YOUNG AS SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Charles R. Young is hereby appointed as special police officer (unarmed) for the Public Works Department, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

- 1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power, except as hereinafter limited, granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties. Such powers and performance of duties by said police officers are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his positions as Code Enforcement Inspector for the Public Works Department.
- 2. That said special police officer shall not be considered an employee of the Chattanooga Police Department, nor shall he be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers of the City, and shall in all respects be considered an employee of Public Works Department.
- 3. That such appointments shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's employment as Code Enforcement Inspector by the Public Works Department. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
