A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, ARTS & CULTURE TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE BYRNE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INNOVATION PROGRAM COMPETITIVE GRANT (CFDA #16.817) TO PROVIDE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROGRAMMING, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the Administrator of the Department of Education, Arts & Culture is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, accept a United States Department of Justice Byrne Criminal Justice Innovation Program Competitive Grant (CFDA #16.817) to provide neighborhood revitalization programming, for an amount not to exceed \$1 million.

The plan is to implement place-based, community-oriented strategies in high crime areas of Chattanooga. The Department of Education, Arts & Culture would serve as the fiscal agent and coordinator for a consortium of cross-sector partners through the Remember Your Dream Program.
