- 4. The proposed Awnings must meet the minimum elevation requirements as per City Codes and Standards.

- 4. The proposed Awnings must meet the minimum elevation requirements as per City Codes and Standards.

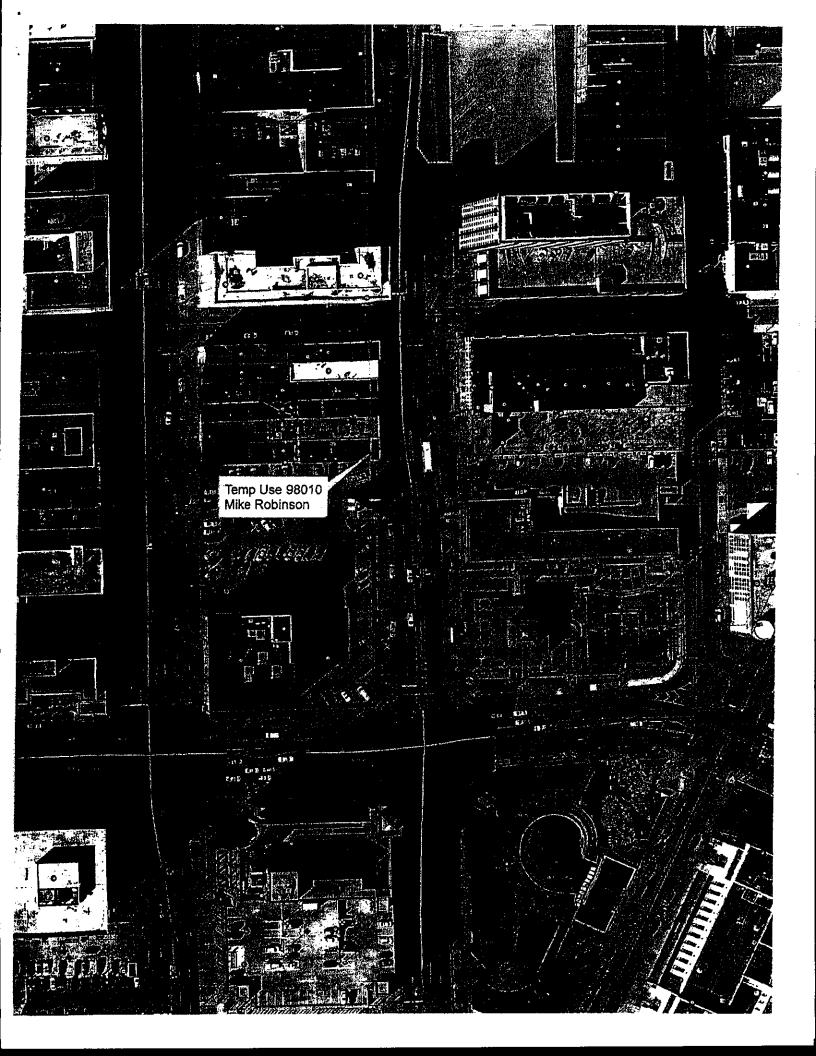

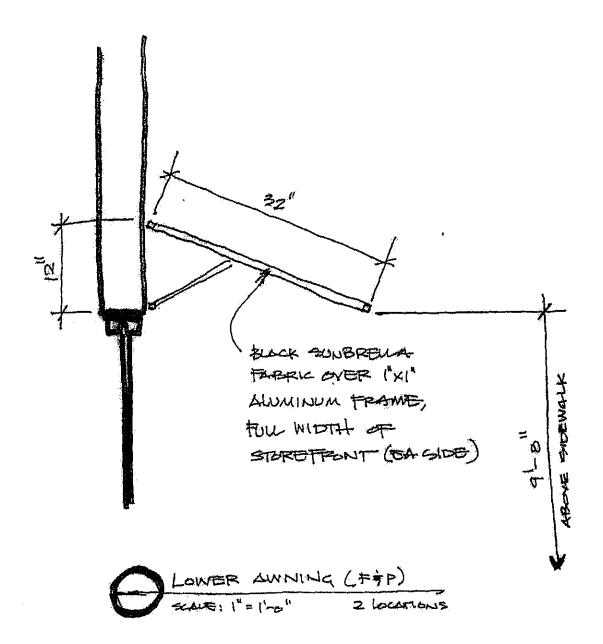

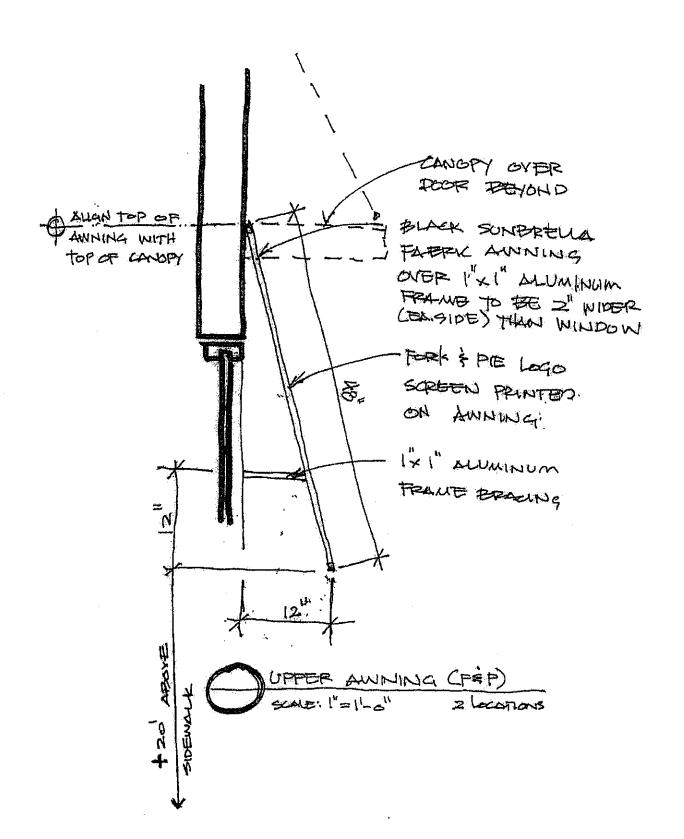
