

RESOLUTION NO. 27820

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SCHAAK VAN DEUSEN TO USE TEMPORARILY THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE PARK LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF GEORGIA AVENUE AND McCALLIE AVENUE (“STEEPLE PARK”) TO INSTALL A MARKER HONORING ABBY CRAWFORD MILTON, AS SHOWN ON THE MAPS AND PHOTOS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That SCHAAK VAN DEUSEN, (hereinafter referred to as “Temporary User”) be and is hereby permitted to use temporarily the right-of-way of the park located at the corner of Georgia Avenue and McCallie Avenue (“Steeple Park”) to install a marker honoring Abby Crawford Milton, as shown on the maps and photos attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said temporary usage shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. Temporary User may execute the Indemnification Agreement prior to the granting of a temporary use by the City Council provided that any obligation to Indemnify and hold the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees harmless for any claims for damages for injuries to persons or property shall be void if the Temporary Use is not granted to applicant by the Chattanooga City Council. Temporary User agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of the Indemnification Agreement in the event a temporary use is granted by the City Council.

2. Temporary User agrees to vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so.

3. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.

4. The sign is to be no closer than two (2) feet from the back of the sidewalk.

5. Text is to be shown on the attached photo of the sign and approved by the State of Tennessee.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

This Indemnification Agreement is entered into by and between THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE (hereinafter the "City"), and SCHAAK VAN DEUSEN (hereinafter "Temporary User"), this 1st day of April, 2014.

For and in consideration of the granting of the temporary usage of the right-of-way of the park located at the corner of Georgia Avenue and McCallie Avenue ("Steeple Park") to install a marker honoring Abby Crawford Milton, as shown on the maps and photos attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Temporary User agrees as follows:

1. Temporary User may execute the Indemnification Agreement prior to the granting of a temporary use by the City Council provided that any obligation to Indemnify and hold the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees harmless for any claims for damages for injuries to persons or property shall be void if the Temporary Use is not granted to applicant by the Chattanooga City Council. Temporary User agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of the Indemnification Agreement in the event a temporary use is granted by the City Council.

2. Temporary User shall vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so; the parties hereto agree that "reasonable notice" shall be deemed to be thirty (30) days. Temporary User shall restore the property to its original condition when it is returned to the City.

3. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.

4. The sign is to be no closer than two (2) feet from the back of the sidewalk.

5. Text is to be shown on the attached photo of the sign and approved by the State of Tennessee.

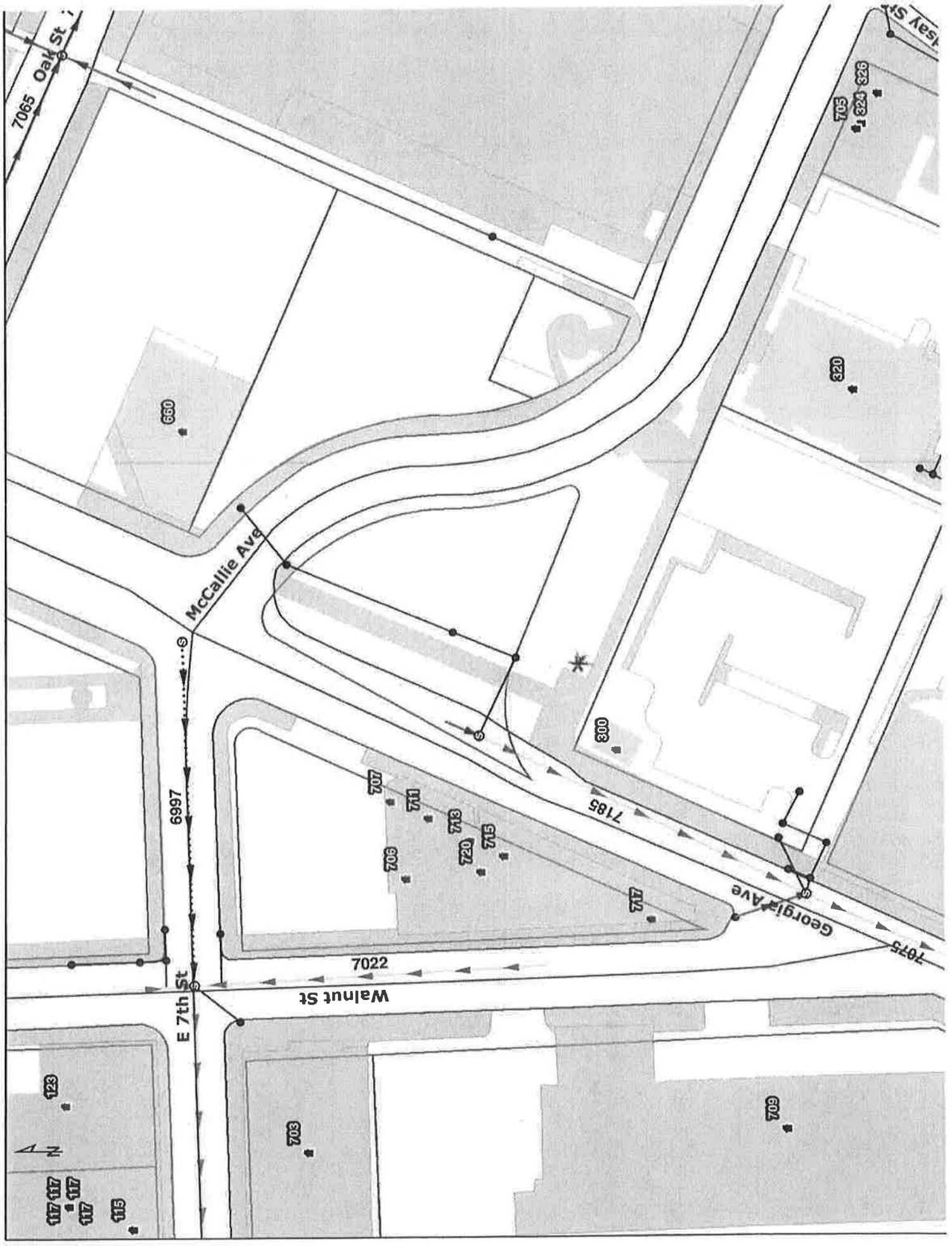

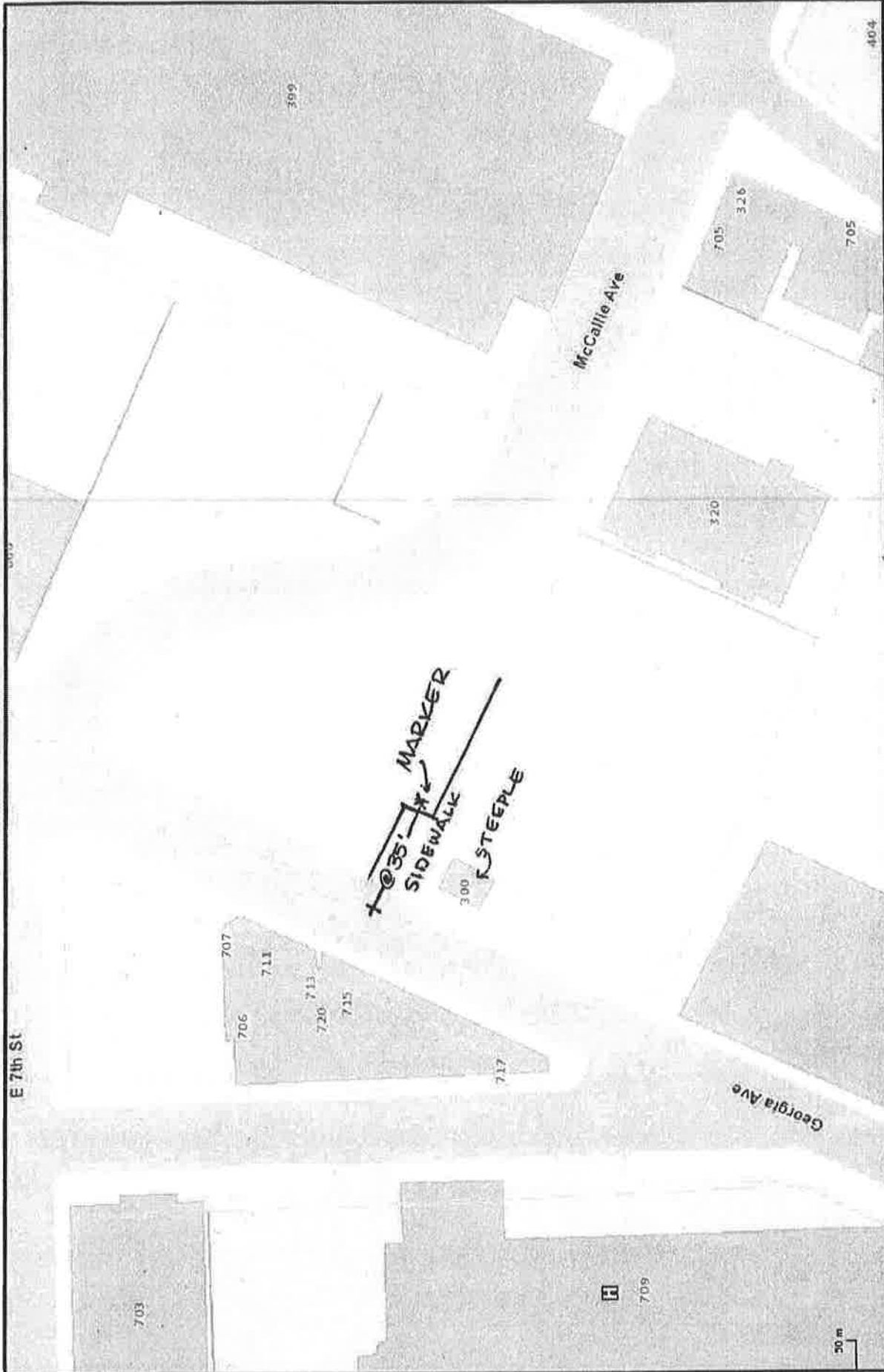

ABBY CRAWFORD MILTON
1881-1991

Abby C. Milton of Chattanooga was a leader in the women's suffrage movement in Tennessee. The campaign culminated in a vote by the Tennessee Legislature in 1920 to ratify the 19th Amendment to the U. S. Constitution, giving women the right to vote. As the last president of the Tennessee Equal Suffrage Association and the first president of the Tennessee League of Women Voters, Milton's leadership was manifest before, during, and after this historic event. At the 1924 Democratic National Convention, she seconded the nomination of William Gibbs McAdoo as the party's presidential candidate.
