BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That WASHINGTON HILLS NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION C/O CALVIN JONES, (hereinafter referred to as "Temporary User") be and is hereby permitted to install a neighborhood sign at 4628 Oakwood Drive, as shown on the photo attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said temporary usage shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Temporary User may execute the Indemnification Agreement prior to the granting of a temporary use by the City Council provided that any obligation to Indemnify and hold the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees harmless for any claims for damages for injuries to persons or property shall be void if the Temporary Use is not granted to applicant by the Chattanooga City Council. Temporary User agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of the Indemnification Agreement in the event a temporary use is granted by the City Council.
- 2. Temporary User agrees to vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so.
- 3. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.

- 4. The sign cannot have a height greater than 36" above the ground.
- 5. The location is to be approved by Traffic Engineering before installation.
- 6. The location is to be outside of the 25' sight triangle.

Recommendations Regarding Temporary Usage Request

I have completed my review of Mr. Jones' request regarding Temporary Usage of 4628 Oakwood Drive for installation of a neighborhood sign as shown on the attached photo. My comments are as follows:

- The sign will serve as the primary source of information regarding neighborhood meetings and events.
- The sign will be a non-illuminated letterboard approximately 48" wide x 36" high x 3 1/8" deep.
- The city of Chattanooga has no sanitary sewer infrastructure in the subject area.

After review, granting this Temporary Usage does not conflict with the public's interest. Therefore, I recommend that the request for *Temporary Usage be granted with these conditions:*

- The sign cannot have a height greater than 36" above the ground.
- The location is to be approved by Traffic Engineering before installation.
- The location is to be outside of the 25' sight triangle.

6. Temporary user agrees to maintain the property in the condition equal to or better than the condition at the time the temporary use is granted.

7. If this request is for maintaining wells the applicant will upon satisfactory completion of use as determined by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, the wells will be abandoned using standard and acceptable practices, which shall include grouting from the bottom to top with a mixture of Portland cement and powdered bentonite and restoring the surface to its original condition as reasonably as possible.

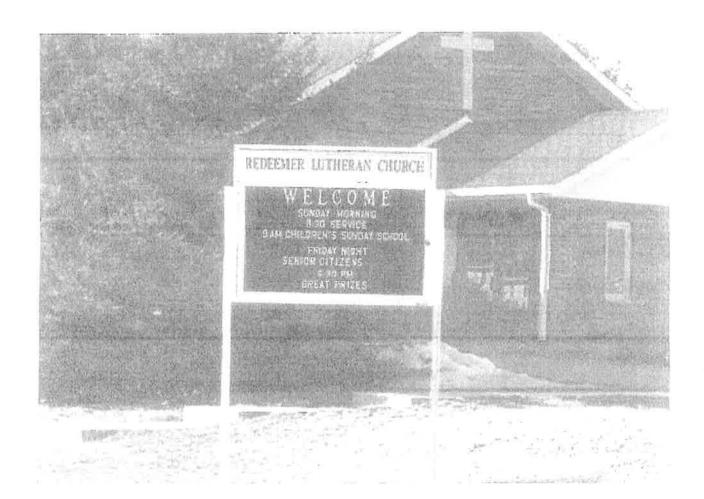
