to apply for and, if awarded, accept a Federal Land Access Program (FLAP) grant from the

Eastern Federal Land Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration to extend the

bicycle and pedestrian transit network from downtown Chattanooga to the Moccasin Bend

National Archeological District, with the City's matching funds in the amount of \$234,260.00,

for an amount not to exceed \$2,238,781.00.
