A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACCESS TO THE CHATTANOOGA COPLINK NODE BETWEEN CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT (486 USERS); HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (165 USERS); CLEVELAND POLICE DEPARTMENT (91 USERS); BRADLEY COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (104 USERS); SIGNAL MOUNTAIN DEPARTMENT (16 USERS); **EAST** RIDGE POLICE DEPARTMENT (38 USERS); AND RED BANK POLICE DEPARTMENT (22 USERS) DESIGNED TO ESTABLISH A COST SHARING AGREEMENT BETWEEN ALL AGENCIES. WITH THE CITY'S PORTION IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR AND 02/100 DOLLARS (\$17,584.02), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$32,563.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby approving a Memorandum of Understanding for access to the Chattanooga Area COPLINK NODE between Chattanooga Police Department (486 Users); Hamilton County Sheriff's Office (165 Users); Cleveland Police Department (91 Users); Bradley County Sheriff's Office (104 Users); Signal Mountain Police Department (16 Users); East Ridge Police Department (38 Users); and Red Bank Police Department (22 Users) designed to establish a cost sharing agreement between all agencies, with the City's portion in the amount of \$17,584.02, for a total amount of \$32,563.00.
