BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, it is hereby authorizing the Administrator for the Department of Public Works to enter into a Joint Funding Agreement (JFA) with the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) and the City of Chattanooga to operate three (3) continuous real-time stream gauges located on North Chickamauga Creek, South Chickamauga Creek, and Chattanooga Creek for the period beginning April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, at a total cost of \$43,500.00, with a contribution of \$10,875.00 from the USGS and \$32,625.00 from the City of Chattanooga.
