

RESOLUTION NO. 29304

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA TO SERVE AS A GOVERNMENT SPONSOR AND PASS-THROUGH ENTITY FOR A GRANT FROM THE AMERICAN BATTLEFIELD PROTECTION PROGRAM, A PART OF THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, TO BE PASSED THROUGH TO THE CIVIL WAR TRUST, WHICH WILL PURCHASE AND PRESERVE A +/-3.61 ACRE PARCEL KNOWN AS THE MOHR TRACT, IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$57,065.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the City of Chattanooga to serve as a government sponsor and pass-through entity for a grant from the American Battlefield Protection Program, a part of the National Park Service, to be passed through to the Civil War Trust, which will purchase and preserve a +/-3.61 acre parcel known as the Mohr Tract, in the amount of \$57,065.00.

The property is located in the core area of Wahatchie and Chattanooga Battlefields, Hamilton County. The City is not providing any funds towards the battlefield acquisition.
