A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENTS OF REBECCA BAECKER, MICHAEL DUPRE, AND DAMON

BUXTON AS SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS (UNARMED) FOR **AREA**

CHATTANOOGA **REGIONAL** TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (CARTA), TO DO SPECIAL

DUTIES AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN

CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That REBECCA BAECKER, MICHAEL DUPRE, AND DAMON BUXTON are

hereby appointed as special police officers for the Chattanooga Area Regional Transportation

Authority (CARTA), subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officers shall have, possess and exercise every power

granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police

officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of their duties, except they shall

not be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police

officers are expressly limited to the performance of duties in their positions as Parking

Ambassadors for CARTA, for the City of Chattanooga.

2. That said special police officers shall not be considered regular police officers and

shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police officers'

employment by CARTA, for the City of Chattanooga. Notwithstanding any other provision

herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointments

at any time.
