A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WOOD E&I SOLUTIONS, INC. C/O MARTHA WOODS, ON BEHALF OF PROPERTY OWNER, BOB WITSELL, TO USE TEMPORARILY THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED ALONG THE **MADISON** STREET ROAD FRONTAGE OF 700 E. MAIN STREET FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A FENCE, AS SHOWN ON THE MAPS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE, **SUBJECT** TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That WOOD E&I SOLUTIONS, INC. C/O MARTHA WOODS, ON BEHALF OF PROPERTY OWNER, BOB WITSELL (hereinafter referred to as "Temporary User"), be and is hereby permitted to use temporarily the right-of-way located along the Madison Street road frontage of 700 E. Main Street for the purpose of installing a fence, as shown on the maps attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said temporary usage shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Temporary User may execute the Indemnification Agreement prior to the granting of a temporary use by the City Council provided that any obligation to Indemnify and hold the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees harmless for any claims for damages for injuries to persons or property shall be void if the Temporary Use is not granted to applicant by the Chattanooga City Council. Temporary User agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of the Indemnification Agreement in the event a temporary use is granted by the City Council.
- 2. Temporary User agrees to vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so.

3. For traffic safety, the fence may not be placed within five (5) feet of the paved

road edge.

5. Temporary User shall obtain any and all necessary permits and approvals from the

City of Chattanooga Land Development Office.

6. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities

located within the easement, is responsible for verifying all utility locations within the subject

area prior to initiating the agreed usage, as well as the protection of said utilities for the duration

of this permit.
