

RESOLUTION NO. 31686

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF NATHANIEL BEGUE AS A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, CHATTANOOGA PARKING AUTHORITY, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN IN THE POSITION OF PARKING AMBASSADOR, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That NATHANIEL BEGUE, be and is hereby appointed as special police officer for the City of Chattanooga, Chattanooga Parking Authority, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess, and exercise every power granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties, except he shall not be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officers are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Parking Ambassador.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointments shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's employment by the City of Chattanooga, Chattanooga Parking Authority. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointments at any time.
