On behalf of Hope For the Inner City, I am writing to communicate my support for the City of Chattanooga as they pursue a grant through the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) discretionary grant funding. The City is pursuing this grant to replace the 70-year old Wilcox Boulevard Bridge over the DeButts Railyard, owned and operated by Norfolk Southern Railway, and over additional tracks operated by CSX Railway. The existing structure can no longer support freight trucks or emergency vehicles, does not offer a safe passageway for pedestrians or bicyclists to cross this large rail facility, and continues to rapidly deteriorate.

A replacement structure is vital to the community and to the transportation network at this location. We provide crisis relief and economic development programs to residents who live in this area, cross the Wilcox Boulevard Bridge daily, and would be negatively impacted disproportionately if anything happens to that bridge before it can be repaired or replaced. Please consider the City's request! Those of us who live and work nearby understand how beneficial this project would be for our community.
